

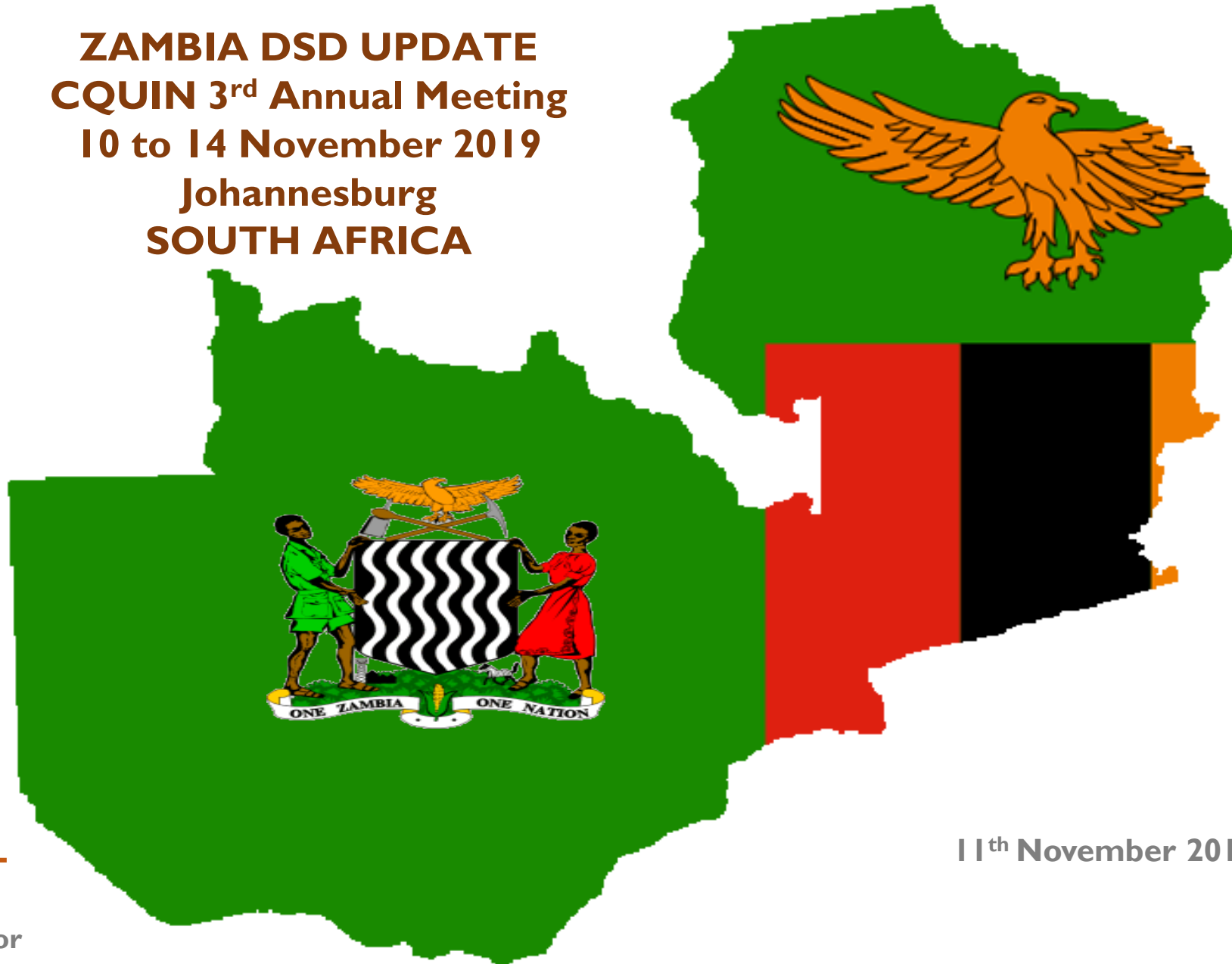

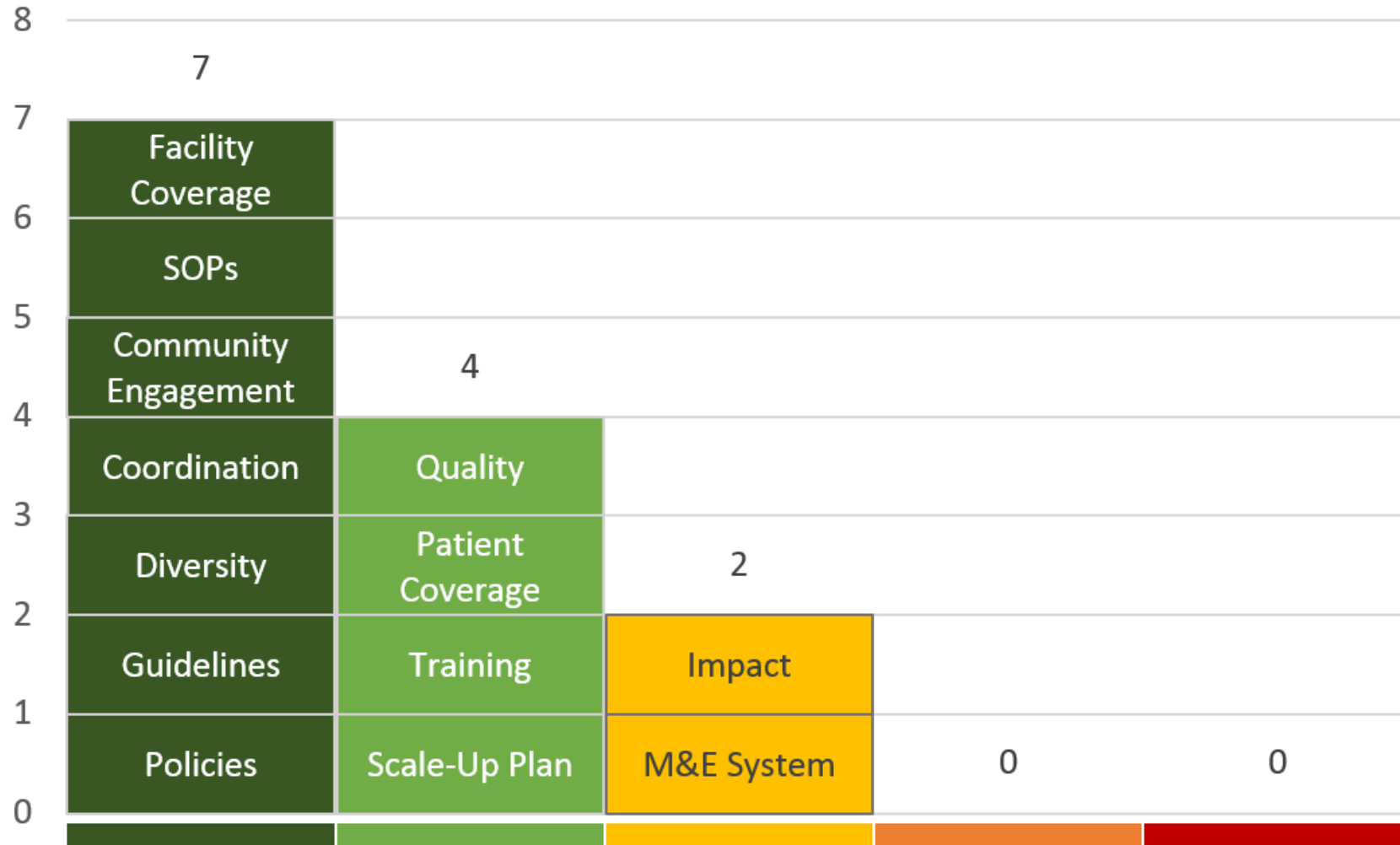

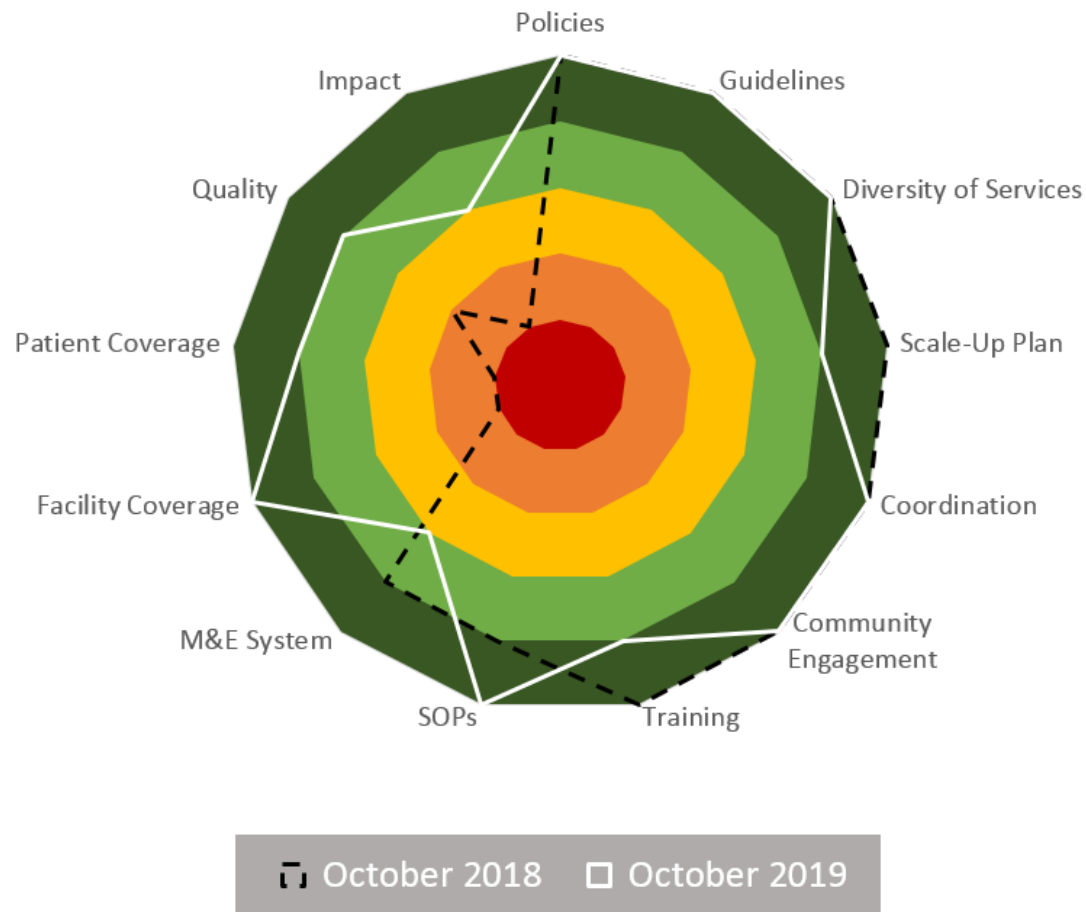

CQUIN Dashboard Results



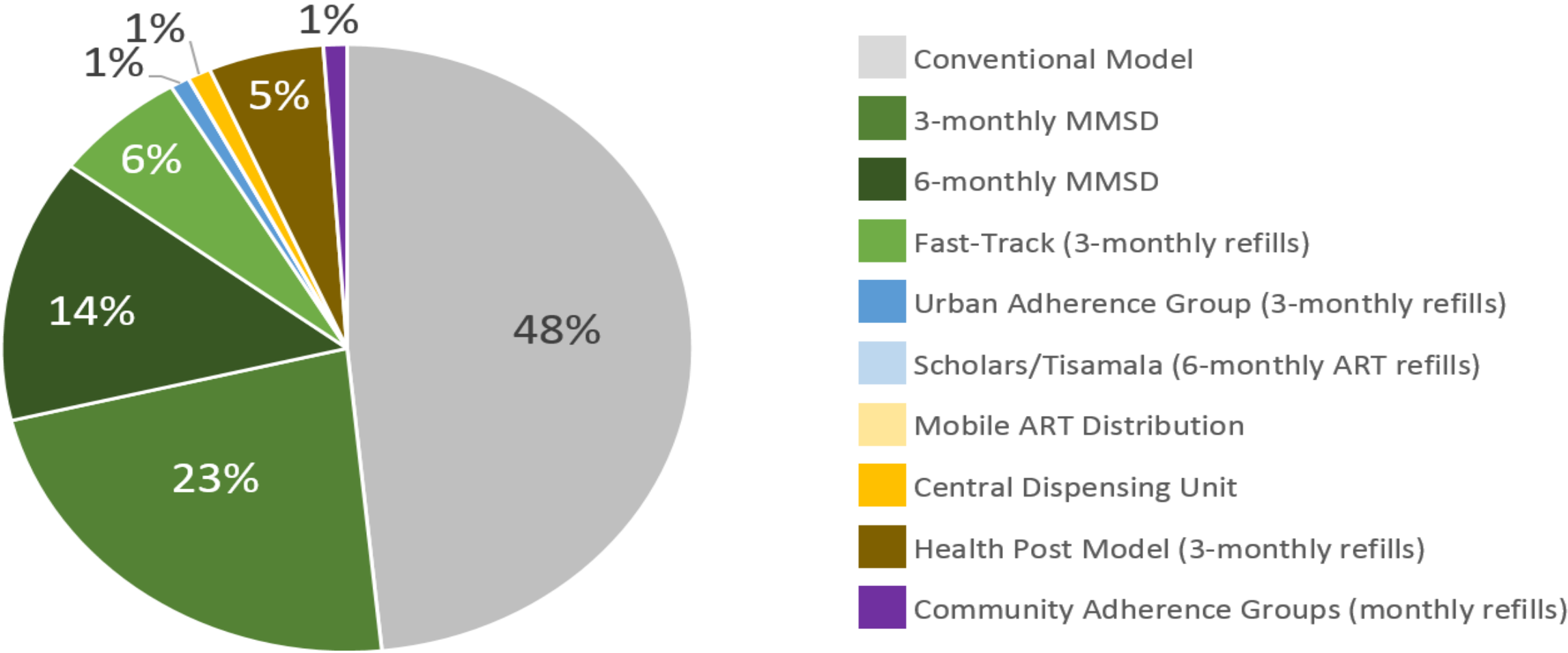
Change in Dashboard Domains since 2018

How did we get here?

- Update on CQUIN Action Plan from 11/2018
 1. Implemented successfully the following activities
 - Incorporated DSD data elements into the national M&E system
 - Developed the 2019 DSD National Training Package
 - 86% of the facilities providing at least one of the national DSD models
 2. One activity that is still underway is
 - Finalization of the National DSD Quality Standards

Successes

1. Incorporation of DSD into the national EMR – SmartCare
2. Development of the standardised DSD National Training package
3. Introduction of 6 month MMSD
4. Won the shark tank competition
