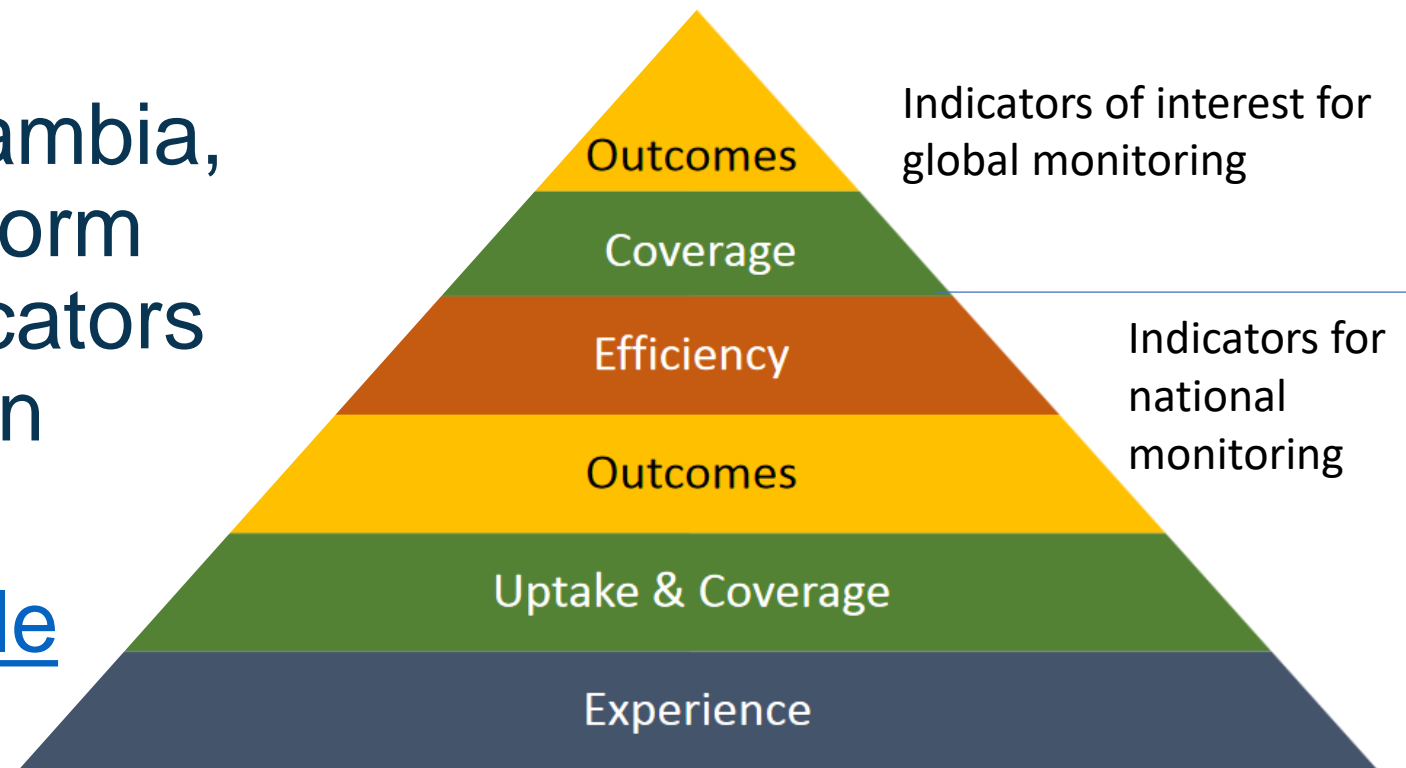

# Introduction to M&E CoP

- **Formation**
  - Need for monitoring & evaluation-focused committee identified at CQUIN Launch Meeting in March 2017
- **Membership**
  - 19 M&E experts from six countries
  - Three additional countries in talks to join and welcoming new members at any time
- **Goals**
  - Share experiences, identify opportunities for South to South learning and ICAP technical assistance around M&E for DSD
  - Collaborate on co-created tools to address challenges of M&E for DSD

# Co-created Tool: M&E Framework for DSD

- Created by CoP members 2017-2018
- Utilized by Zimbabwe, Zambia, and other countries to inform definition of national indicators and design data collection tools for data reviews

# Co-created Tool: DSD Data Review Toolkit

## WHO

- Designed for use by ministries of health
- Directed at DSD Coordinators and M&E experts

## WHAT

Guidelines on planning for and conducting data review  
Sample tools, slide templates, recommended analyses

## WHY?

## WHERE

- Flexible enough to be used in any country context
- Recommended for use at sub-national levels

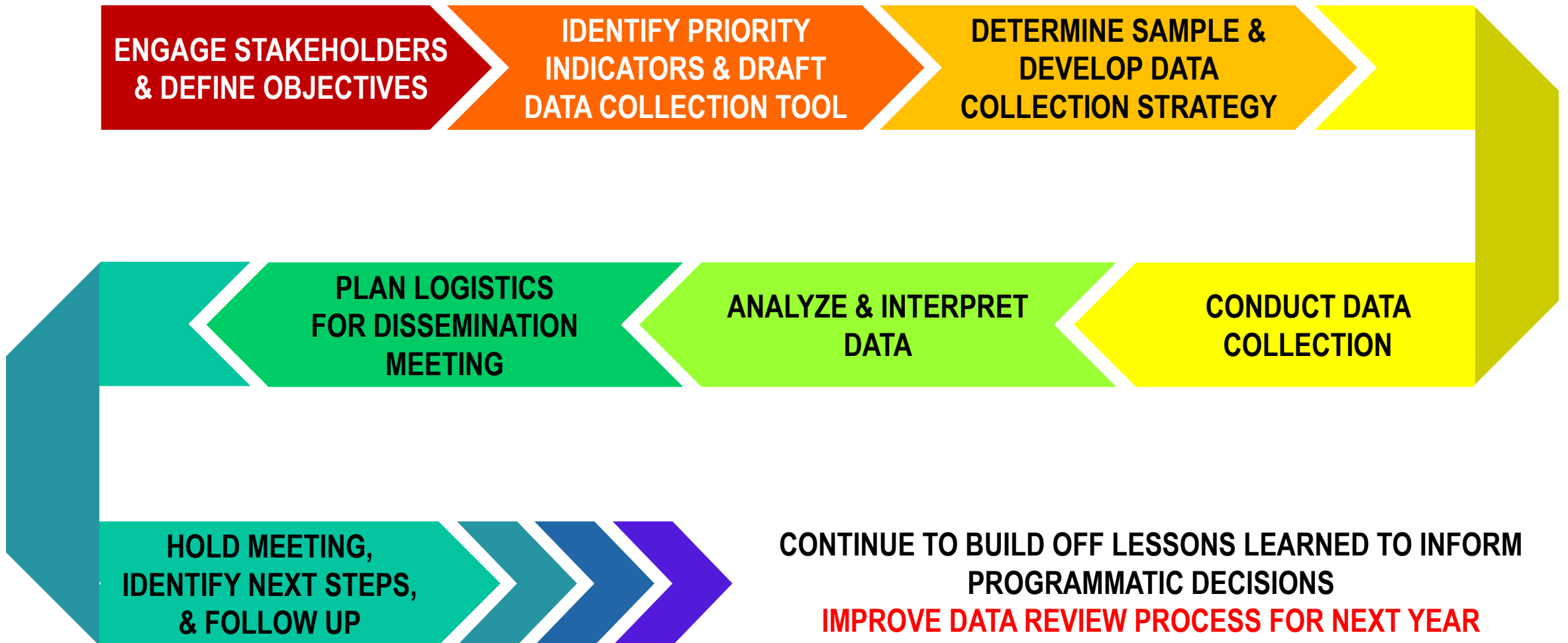
## WHEN

When gaps in national data prevent routine reporting  
Can be conducted yearly to monitor progress over time

# Rationale for DSD Data Reviews

- **Successes**
  - CQUIN Network countries have made great progress in scaling up DSD
- **Common Challenges**
  - Limited availability of data for monitoring coverage, retention, and outcomes on DSD
  - Modifying existing M&E systems to allow for routine reporting of DSD data is a major undertaking and progress can be slow
- **Increasing Demands for Data**
  - Data is in high demand for monitoring of DSD implementation and program quality
  - PEPFAR beginning to require reporting of DSD data

# Questions Answered by DSD Data Reviews

- Which DSD models are more popular among men compared to women?
- Which age groups are more engaged in DSD?
- Are people maintaining VLS after one year in community-based models? After two or more years?
- Are people switching between DSD models?
- Are people being enrolled into DSD models appropriately?
- Is DSD achieving increased efficiency for the ART program?



# Next Steps

- Toolkit is currently in draft form
- Collecting feedback, lessons learned, and best practices from countries that are implementing DSD data reviews
- Final toolkit will be available on the CQUIN website and will be promoted at CQUIN meetings and in newsletters
