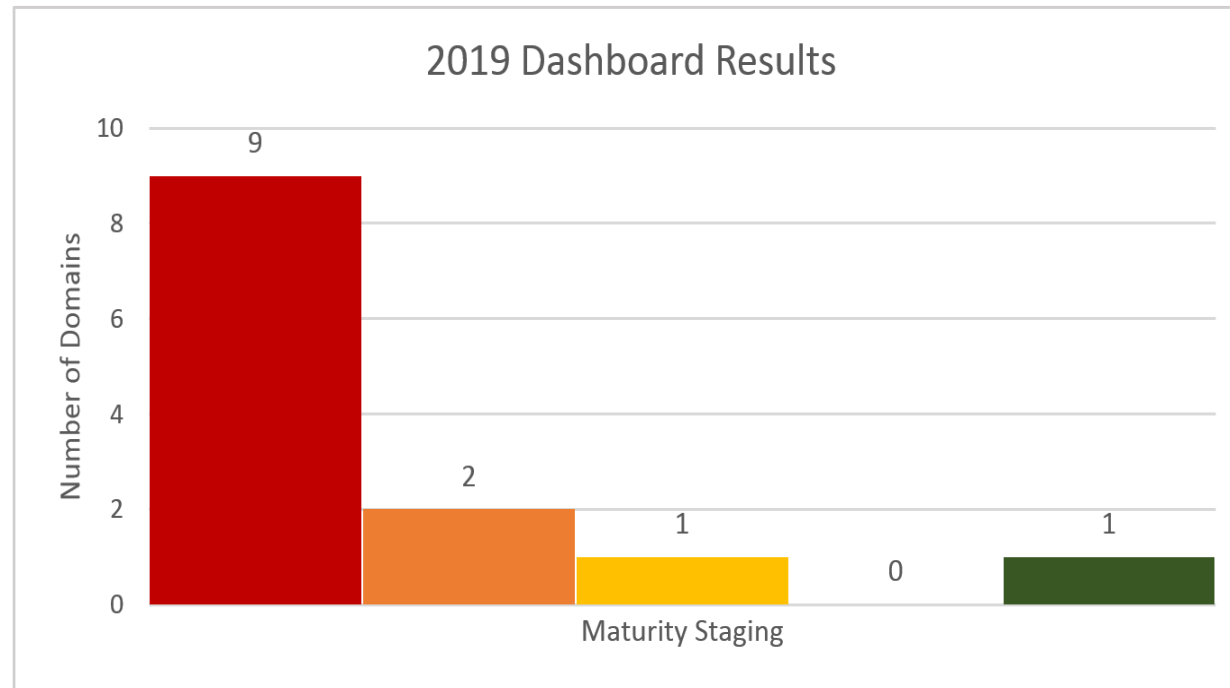

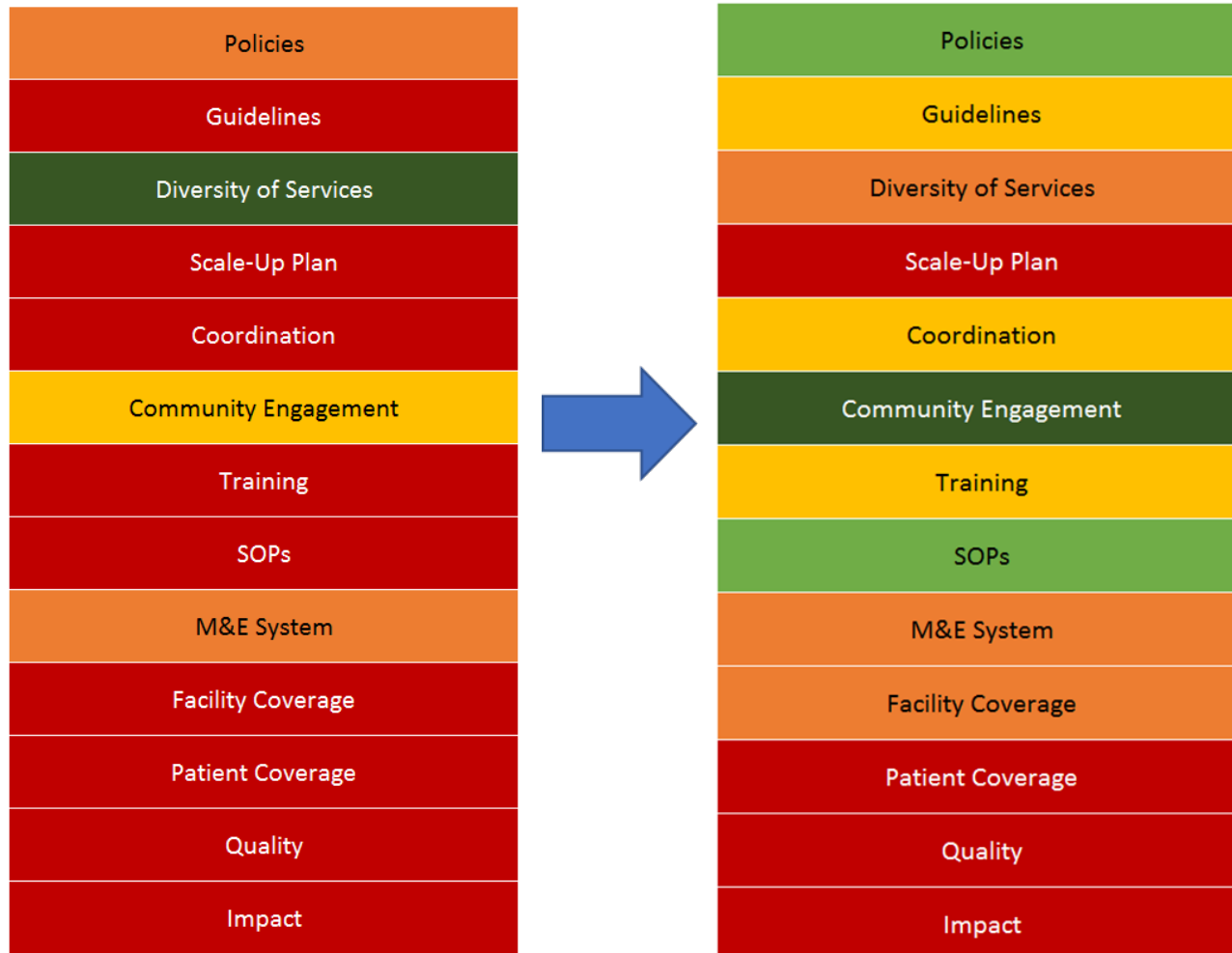
CQUIN Dashboard Results: 2019

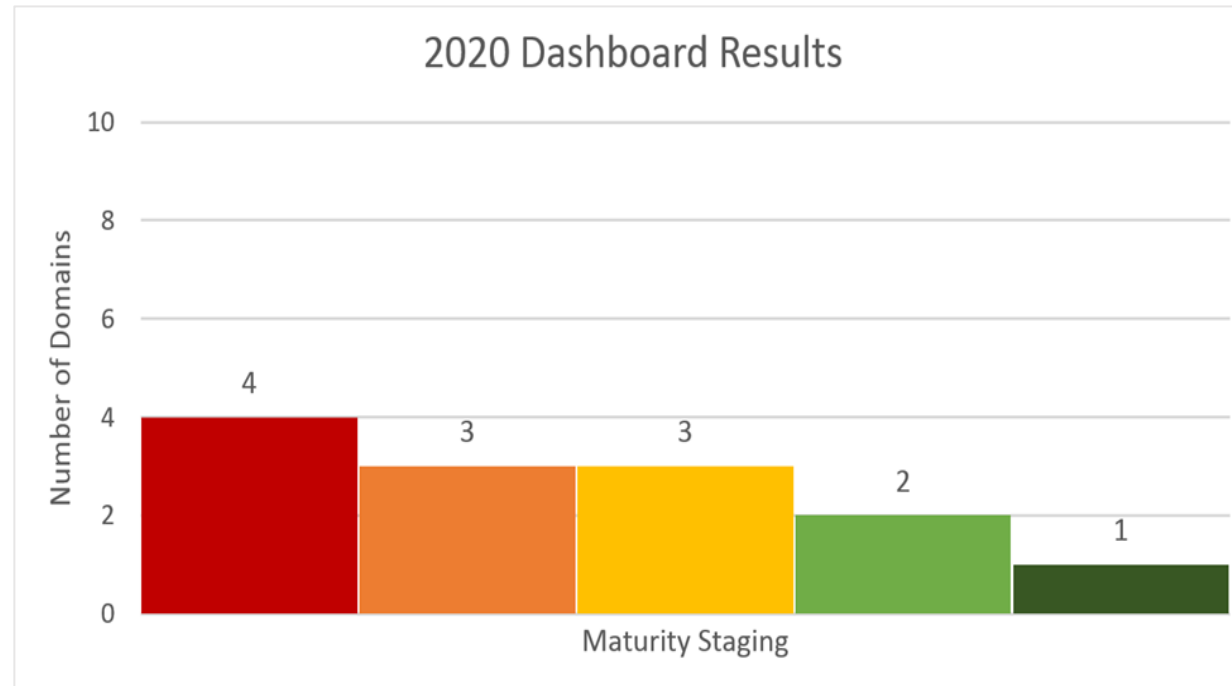
- Liberia's entry into the CQUIN network has significantly impacted DSD scale up in the country.
- At entry, the majority of domains on the dashboard ; (9) were in red with 1 in yellow, red and Orange respectively.

Change in Dashboard Domains since 2019



- Progress has been made in eight (8) domains since joining the CQUIN network last year.
- Specific domains for progress as graded by the CQUIN Dashboard includes - Policy, Guidelines, Coordination, Community Engagement, Training, SOPs, and Facility Coverage.
- Regression was seen in 1 domain – Diversity due to the non-existence of specific models for teenagers (are adopted but inactive).

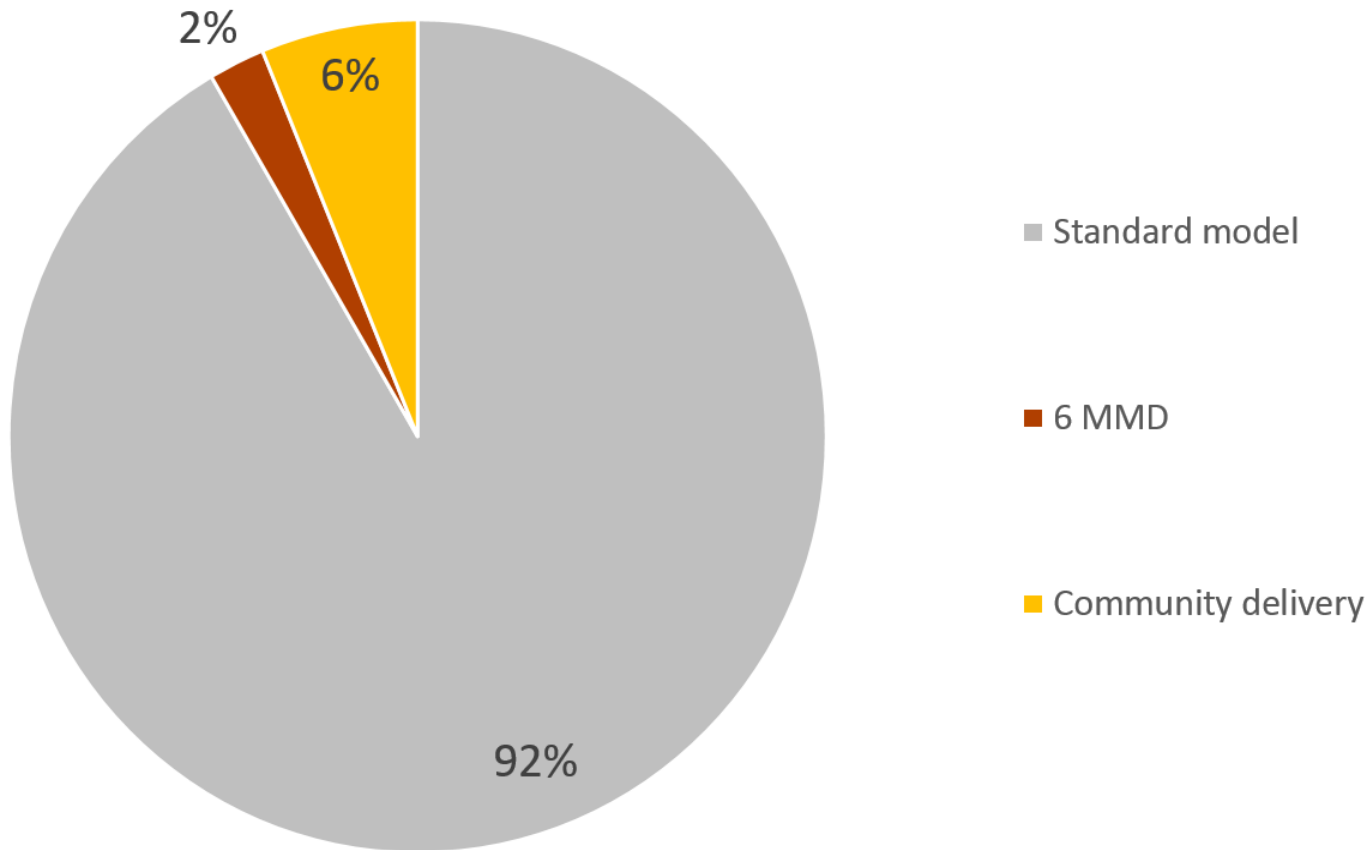
CQUIN Dashboard Results: 2020



Currently, four (4) domains remain in red, with three (3) in Orange, 3 in yellow, 2 in light green and 1 in dark green.

Nationally, our goal is to gradually transition more of our red domains to yellow and green.

Model Mix



- Two models are actively implemented in addition to the standard of practice (3MMD):
 - Community Delivery
 - 6 MMD
- Data shown is from 1 of 15 counties in Liberia (Montserrado, n=31 facilities and 10,523 recipients of care. Nationally, there were 17,269 recipients of care on ART.)

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Update on CQUIN Action Plan from 11/2019

- **Activities that have been successfully completed include:**
 - Establishment of regular community engagement sessions
 - Development of SOP and roll out of 6 MMD
 - Training on DSD for high burden facilities in one (1) county – Montserrado
 - Update of national M & E recording tools to include DSD model
 - South to south visit to Ethiopia
- **One activity that was dropped or that is still underway is:**
 - Demand creation and treatment literacy for DSD is still underway

Key policy and practice adaptations made in response to COVID19 - 2

- Peer-led home delivery of ART for key populations
- 3 MMD to all PLHIV regardless of eligibility criteria
 - Non-adherent recipients of care received 3-MMD through Fast Track clinics during the COVID-19 lockdown and curfew periods only.

Successes

- Establishment of a community engagement forum
- Inclusion of DSD in the national integrated guidelines
- Roll out of 6-MMD
- 1 successful learning exchange with Ethiopia

Challenges (other than COVID-19)

- Delay in roll out of M & E tools
- Absence of demand creation for DSD
- Infrastructure and human resource challenges affecting DSD roll out

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2021 Goals and Targets

By CQUIN's 5th annual meeting (end-2021):

- Develop National DSD Scale up plan
- 50% of people on ART in Montserrado will be in less-intensive DSD models
- Scale up 6-MMD to more facilities and RoC
- Harmonize & integrate TB/HIV services (refill for TB treatment & TPT) into less-intensive models
- To improve Quality domain score on dashboard from red to yellow by end 2021
