The CQUIN Project for Differentiated Service Delivery

RISE works in 4 states of Nigeria
2 in the north, Adamawa & Niger
2 in the South Cross River & Akwa Ibom
aiming to achieve HIV epidemic control

Out break of COVID-19 lead to movement restriction, low hospital attendance with risk of HEI missing out on EID

RISE launched interventions to mitigate impact of lockdown on PLHIV. Community/home visit and use of DBS for EID sample collection

Home/community EID using DBS maintained services during COVID lockdown

EID Services maintained in the mist of lockdown

Pre-lockdown Oct '19 – March '20
690 samples collected 57% (393/690) collected with 2 months
Av TAT 30 days

COVID Lockdown April – Sept 20
634 samples collected 60% (379/634) collected with 2 months of birth
Av TAT 34 days

VS

Results are returned to facility
Clients tracked for ART enrolment (+ve) or follow up (-ve)

-Health worker trained and deployed for DBS collection at home
- Clients escorted to nearby facility for DBS collection where skill is lacking
