Status of some elements of DSD (Global vs CQUIN)

- Self testing in national policy
 - o **105/178 (59%)**
 - o **21/21 (100%)**
- Viral load testing in national policy
 - o **79/81** (98%)
 - o **17/21 (81%)**
- Lay-provider performing HIV Testing
 - o **75/166** (45%)
 - o **19/21 (90%)**
- TB Preventive Treatment (TPT)
 - o **98/115** (85%)
 - o **14/21** (67%)
- CrAg
 - o **53/115** (46%)
 - o **15/21 (71%)**
- LF-LAM as TB diagnosis
 - o **29/115** (25%)
 - o **17/21 (81%)**

Unpacking Self-testing implementation

- National wide
 - o **42/105 (40%)**
 - o **13/21 (62%)**
- Only at sub-national level/selected district
 - o **21/105 (20%)**
 - o **5/21 (24%)**
- Only as Pilot
 - o **27/105 (19%)**
 - o **2/21 (9.5%)**
- Not implemented anywhere in country
 - o **15/105 (14%)**
 - o **1/21 (4.8%)**

Unpacking Viral Load testing implementation

VL monitoring in % of facilities in reporting countries with VL in national policy

- Over 95%

 61/79 (77%)
 13/17 (76%)
- >50-95%
 11/79 (23%)
 4/17 (24%)
- <50%
 - o **3/79 (3.8%)**
 - o **0**
- Data not available
 - 4/79 (5%)
 - 0
