
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Progress Towards the 95:95:95 Targets



- Zambia has reached most mature score in 9 domains, two are in light green
- TB/HIV and NCD/HIV are in yellow while M&E, Key population and Family planning domains are in orange mainly due to limitation in data capturing tools to increase visibility at national level
- MCH is in red because the national guidelines currently do not recommend less intensives models to PBFW
- For the quality domain, no SQAs have taken place and for the impact domain, no national DSD evaluation has been conducted


Zambia Treatment CMM Results: Change Over Time



- 8 Domains have been maintained in dark green compared to 2023 performance and 2 domains have maintained light green stage of maturity
- The Diversity domain matured from light green to dark green
- The M&E domain regressed from dark green in 2023 to orange in 2024 while HIV/TB regressed from light green to yellow due to an EMR system failure to generate the report




Zambia Differentiated Treatment Model Mix

Zambia Differentiated Treatment: Multi-Month Dispensing




- As of June 2024, 78% of Recipients of care were on 6 months dispensing compared to 74% in 2023
- 17% of ROC received between 3-5 months ART dispensing while 5% received less than 3 months as of June 2024
- This is mainly attributed to a strong supply chain system that responded to the increased demand for multi-month dispensing models

- A total of 11 domains are mature while four (Quality, Impact and Client Coverage 1&2) are in the least mature stage
- Clients' coverage is attributed to lack of AHD specific reports at National level
- There has been no evaluations to assess impact of AHD implementation at the national level


Zambia AHD CMM Results – Trend Over Time (2022-2024)



- Ten (10) domains were staged as most mature compared to 8 in 2023
- Two (2) domains moved from less mature to most mature
- Client coverage 1&2, supply chain, M&E, impact and quality remained unchanged over the last year because there were no national evaluations or quality assessment have been conducted



Zambia Differentiated Testing CMM – 2024



Generally, there has been improvement in six domains

Finance/Resource Allocation - There has been clear awareness and evidence-based financing and resource allocation towards the HIV testing program

Other domains still stagnant

Knowledge of Status - The country has identified priority groups for testing BUT does not have national data to determine what proportion of each priority group's awareness of HIV status

Overview of HIV Program 2024 CMM Results

- Enabling domains across all the CMMs are most matured (dark green)
- Impact, Quality, and M&E requires prioritizing to reach maturity
- The country is currently working on developing DSD and AHD specific reports in the National EHR system to improve data visibility, hence improving client coverage, and M&E domains
- Following the adaptation of the CQUIN quality standards, service quality assessments will be conducted in the coming year

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Stakeholder Coordination and Prioritization Processes (1)

- The following activities prioritized at CQUIN meeting in the past year and have been confirmed for funding:
 - GF Funding
 - DSD Quality Standards toolkit development
 - Hold supply chain engagement meetings to improve commodity availability for AHD
 - Conduct DSD Performance Review
 - PEPFAR
 - Hold supply chain engagement meetings to improve commodity availability for AHD
 - Build capacity on screening and management of AHD
 - Review evidence around the outcomes of ROCs with annual clinical visit to adapt all the less intensive models basing on annual clinical visits and 12-month refills



Stakeholder Coordination and Prioritization Processes (2)

- The National DSD taskforce meets every 3rd Wednesday of the month to plan and coordinate implementation of activities
 - NZP+ and TALC are the recipients of care organizations that are represented in these meetings
 - CQUIN quality standard tool kit adapted, and local quality standard developed



Update on Country Action Plans from 2024 Meetings (1)

- Activities that have been successfully completed include:
 - Quality standard toolkit development, SQA scheduled for 2025
 - Hold supply chain engagement meetings to improve commodity availability for AHD
 - Build capacity on screening and management of AHD
- Activities that are still ongoing include:
 - Review evidence around the outcomes of ROCs with annual clinical visit to adapt all the less intensive models basing on annual clinical visits and 12-month refills
 - Conduct data review meetings to strengthen Monitoring of AHD indicators
 - Review summary DSD report in Smart care



Update on Country Action Plans From 2024 Meetings (2)

Activities that were dropped include:

- Assess community engagement using the new national community engagement toolkit
- Develop summary reporting tools in the EMR for dHTS
- Conduct client satisfaction survey amongst ROC in DSD
- We plan to re-introduce these activities in the 2025 action plan



Update on Integrating Non-HIV and HIV Services

- There hasn't been much progress following integration meeting
- Integration activities to be included in the 2025 action plan



Program Sustainability Efforts and Opportunities

- Sustainability of DSD activities
 - DSD National Program coordinator is MOH employee. All DSD activities spearheaded by MOH with support from IPs
 - Some activities have been included in the MOH workplan funded by GF
- National sustainability roadmap
 - The sustainability plan still in draft, DSD to be integrated



DSD Implementation Successes in 2024

- Developed the Quality Standard Toolkit
- In collaboration with Department of Defense (DOD) and Defense Forces of Zambia, 116 Health Care providers working in DFZ facilities were trained on DSD
- Held the country staging meeting with support from DOD through CIDRZ
- Integration of NCD care in ART clinics



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DSD Priorities for 2025

2025 Priorities

- DSD Performance Reviews
- Conduct service quality assessments (SQA)
- Strengthen M&E for DSD and AHD
- Integration of NCD care in ART clinics
