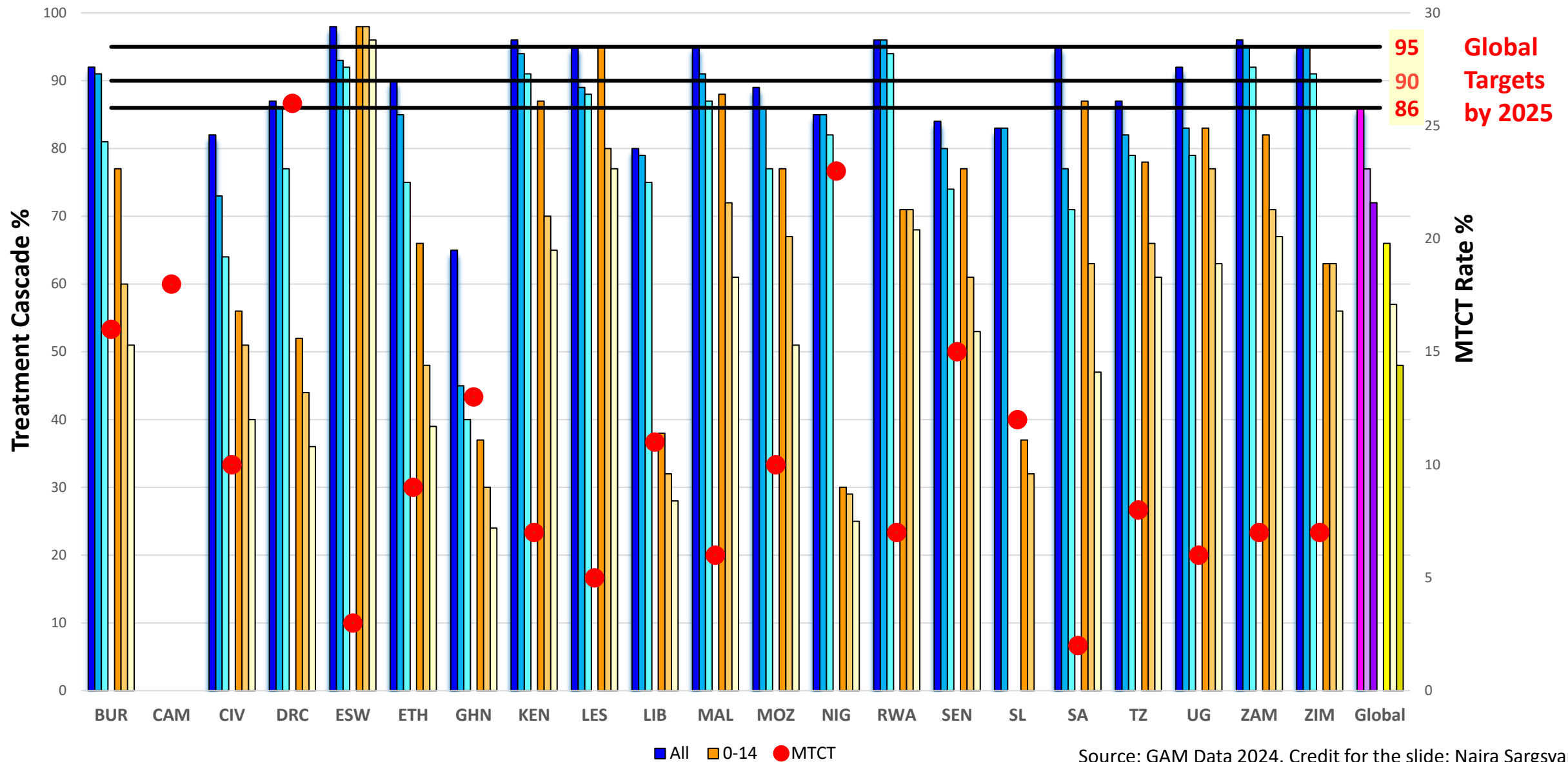

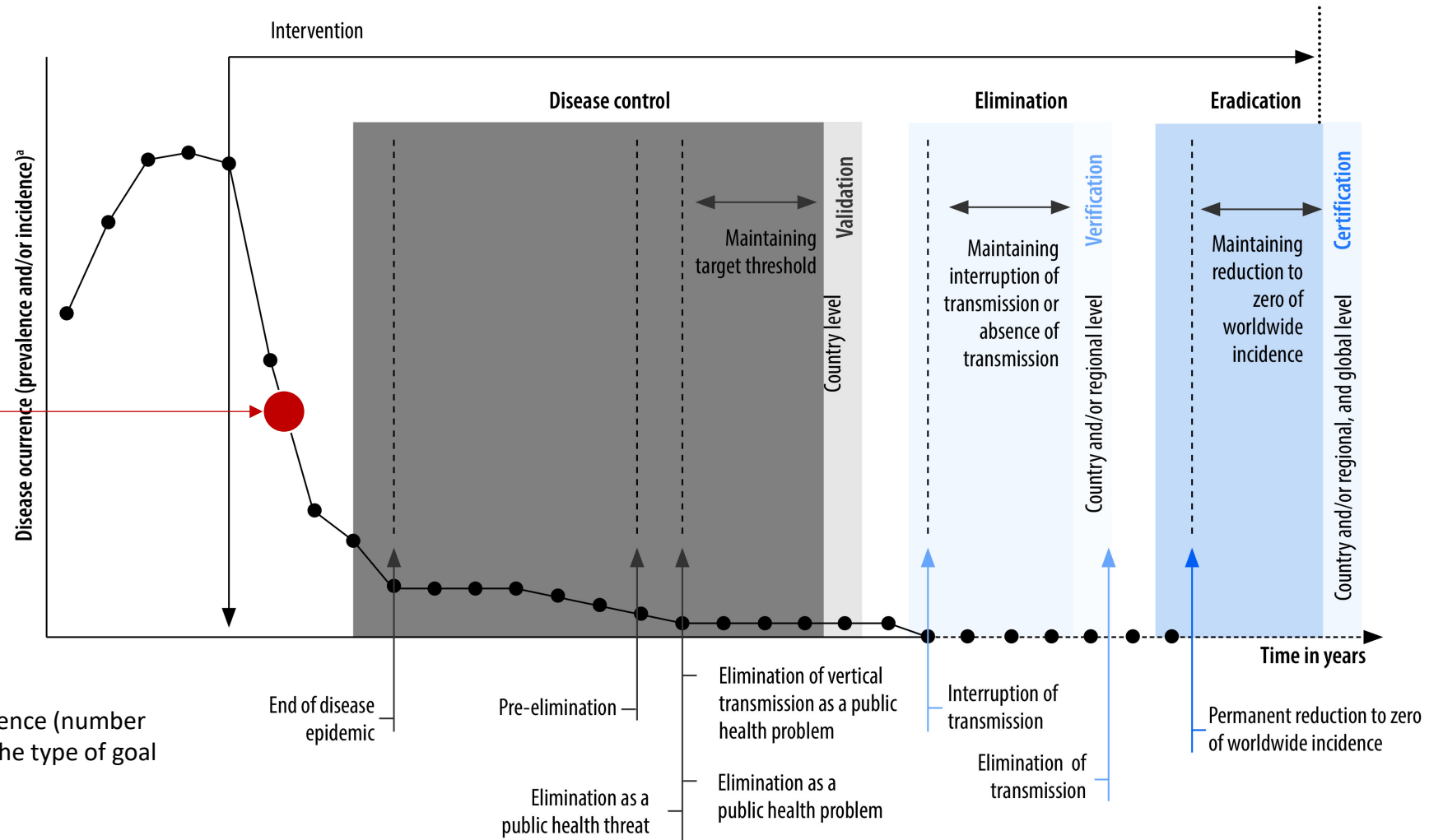


Where we are now - HIV Treatment Cascade & MTCT Rate



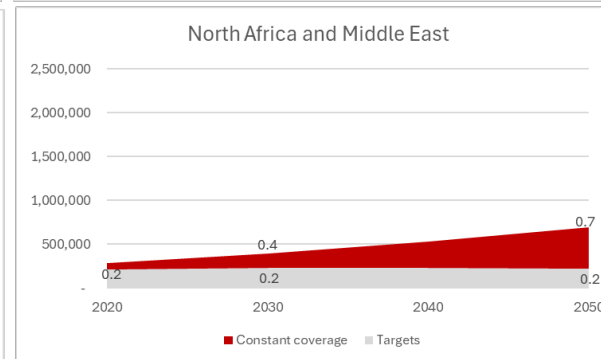
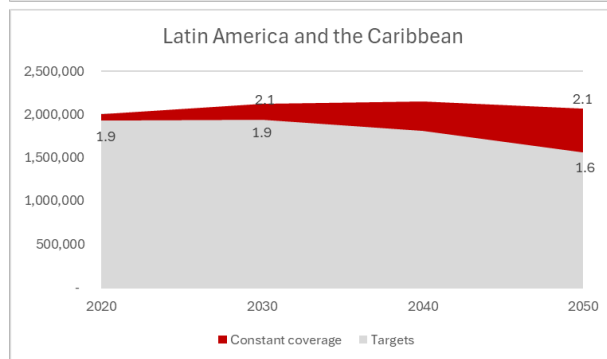
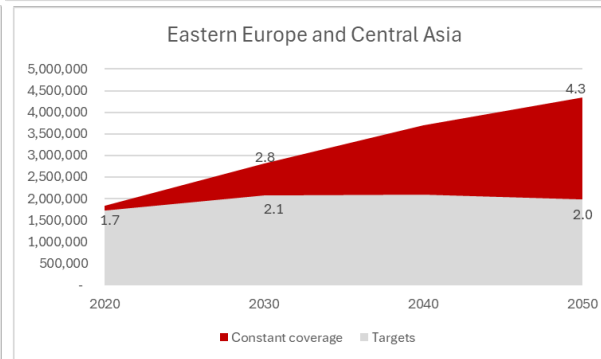
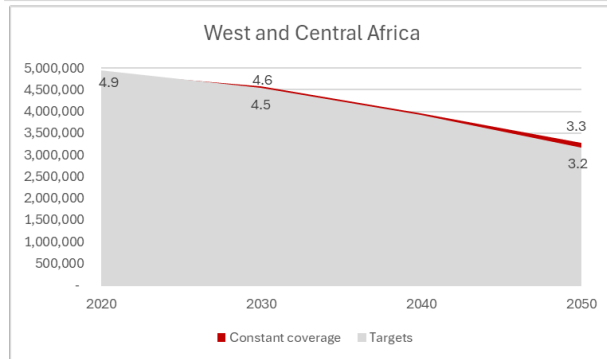
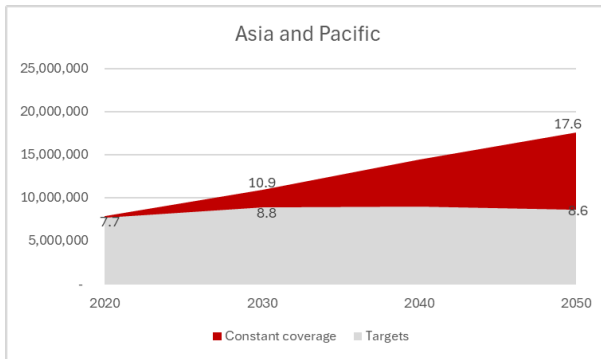
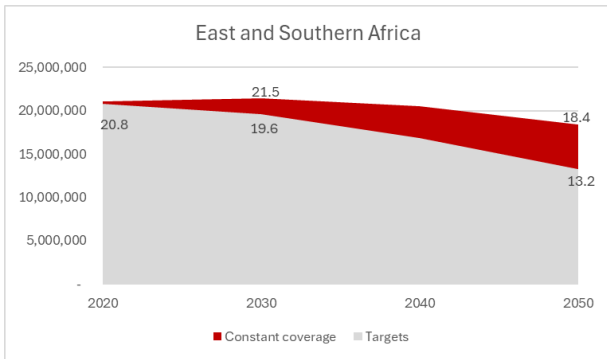
HIV still requires focused interventions to reach “control”

Prevalence (% and/or rate) and/or incidence (number of cases and/or rate), depending upon the type of goal and infectious condition.

Where we are going - Projections of people living with HIV in 2030 and 2050 (meeting 2025 targets vs. current programme levels)



Red projection at current effort
Grey projections if countries meet 2025 targets

Note the different scales on y axis

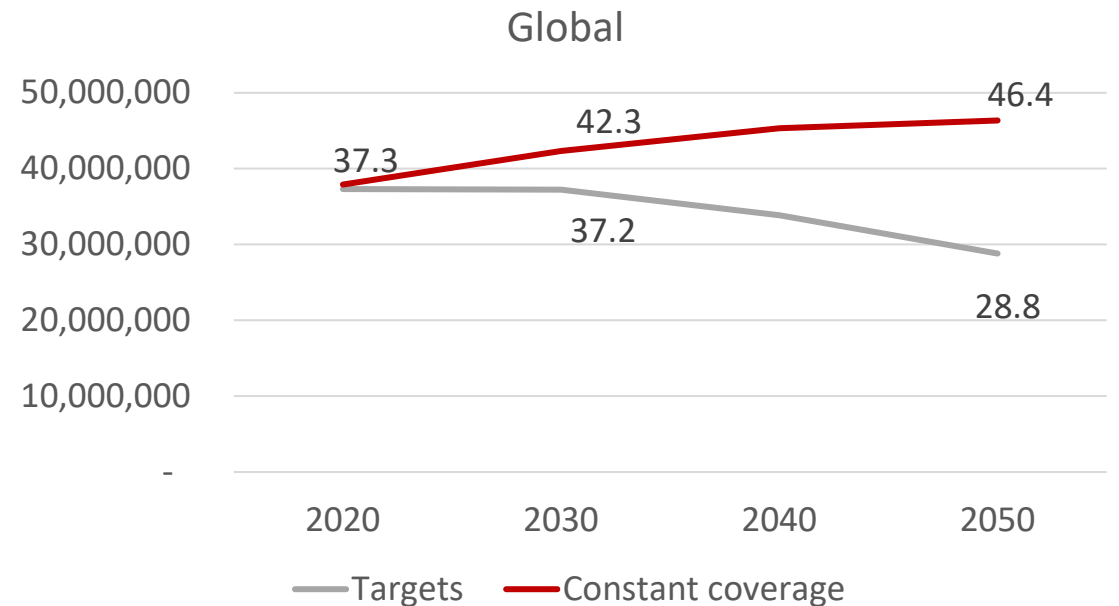
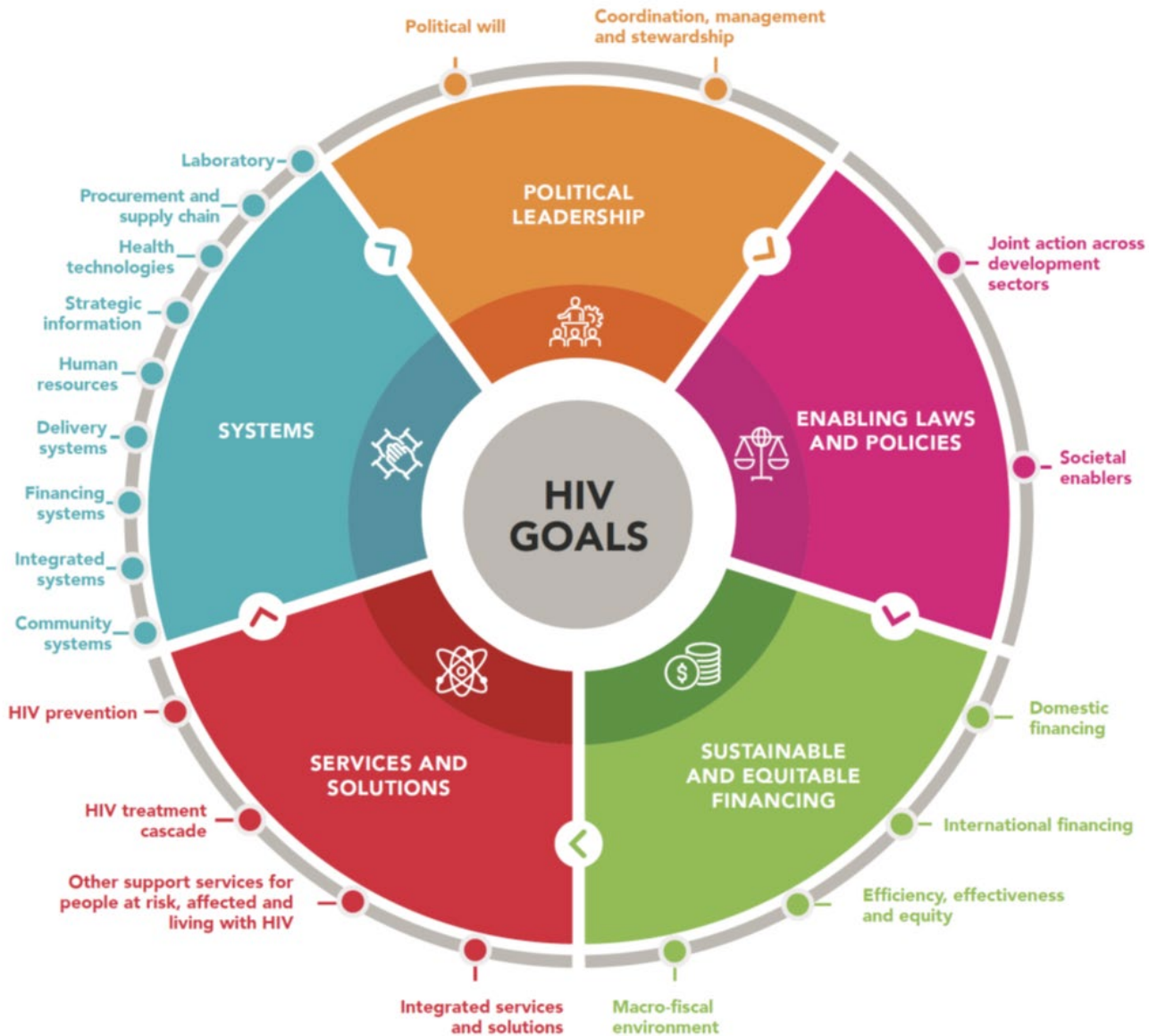


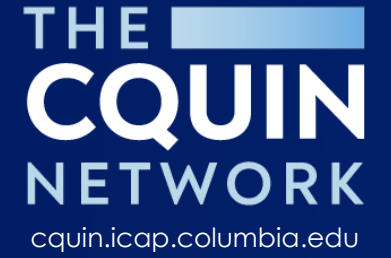
Figure 7. HIV response sustainability domain and sub-domains
